

**Six Ways the
Old Testament
is Used in the
New Testament**

1. **Direct Quote – the exact words from the Old Testament used in the New Testament.**
2. **Some Partial Quote – a few words dropped out.**

3. The writer paraphrases what was said in the Old Testament (or gives the meaning in other words.)
4. Two or more verses are blended together, producing a verse.

5. **The interpretation of the verse is given.**
6. **Quote in the New Testament that seemingly can't be found in the Old Testament.**
