<sup>16</sup>All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

*Six Ways the  
Old Testament  
is Used in the  
New Testament*

1. **Direct Quote** – the exact words from the Old Testament used in the New Testament.
2. **Some Partial Quote** – a few words dropped out.

3. The writer paraphrases what was said in the Old Testament (or gives the meaning in other words.)
4. Two or more verses are blended together, producing a verse.

5. The interpretation of the verse is given.
6. Quote in the New Testament that seemingly can't be found in the Old Testament.
